



December 19, 2009: Secuela will be held at New Hampton Community Church, Main Street, New Hampton Potluck 6:15, Secuela 7:30 p.m.

Directions: Located in downtown New Hampton on Rte 132, the easiest directions are to follow signs to "New Hampton Prep School" - the church is across the street.



From I-93 take exit 23, head West on Rte. 104. At the blinking yellow light, take a left onto Main Street, New Hampton (Rte 132 South.) As you come into town, the church can be seen at the other end of Main Street.

From the West, take Rte 104 East. Five miles beyond Bristol, immediately after crossing the Pemigewasset River, take a right at the blinking yellow light onto Main Street, (Rte. 132 South.) As you come into town, the church can be seen at the other end of Main Street.

Potluck 6:15; Secuela 7:30: Please bring your hot food HOT! Oven capacity is limited.

Directions: Take Rte. 93 to Exit 15W, to North Main Street/North State Street (Rte 3). Turn North on Rte. 3. The church is approximately 2.5 miles on your Left (about 1 mile past the NH State Prison). Parking is available in the rear of the church. Secuela will be held in the Old Parish Hall --- the building on the left.



(Suggestion: bring a torch (flashlight) to light your way. The entrance area to the Parish Hall is difficult to navigate in the dark.)
